

## The 4 different types of sentences

### Statements

Statements are sentences that tell you something. They usually end with a full stop.

Green is my favourite colour.

It will be playtime soon.

The quiet, little boy played with his toys.

### Commands

Commands are sentences that tell you to do something.

They are often urgent or angry and can be very short.

They usually end with a full stop. They can end with an exclamation mark.

Pack your bags.

Come here at once!

Get your water bottle.

### Questions

Questions are sentences that ask you something. They usually end with a question mark.

Have you finished your breakfast?

Where would you like to go on holiday?

When will it be playtime?

### Exclamations

Exclamations are sentences that state something with strong emotion. They begin with 'what' or 'how', are full sentences, include a verb and end with an exclamation mark.

What a lovely day it is for a picnic!

How lucky Dave was to have a special toy like Dogger!

What a terrible thing to happen!
