

## English

Children should learn to:

- Write simple sentences with a capital letter and a full stop
- Understand that stories have a beginning, middle and end.
- Learn the difference between familiar and unfamiliar settings.
- Write a story based on a familiar setting
- Use our sense to help write a poem
- To use 'and' to join two clauses to make a sentence

## Science

Children should learn to:

- Name, draw and label parts of the body.
- Know the 5 senses and which parts of the body they relate to.
- Identify and classify a variety of common animals.

## RE

Children should learn to:

- Identify symbols and objects special to them.
- Identify symbols and objects special to Christians, Buddhists and Jews.
- Understand the festivals of Easter, Wesak and Passover.

## Music

Children should learn to:

- Explore musical concepts such as rhythm, pulse and pitch
- Play instruments to accompany a song or piece of music.
- Begin to improvise and compose.
- Find out about different musical styles.

## Maths

Children should learn to:

- Find and make number bonds
- Add and subtract within 20
- Count in 10s to 50
- Count forwards and backwards to 50
- Understand the value of 10s and 1s in a two digit number
- Represent and compare numbers to 50
- Count in 2s
- Count in 5s

## Computing

Children should learn to:

- Use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs
- Use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.

## Geography

Children should learn to:

- Know key geographical features of the local area inc. forest and town.
- Use simple fieldwork to study the location of their school and its grounds.
- Identify the names and features of the seasons.

## PSHE

Children should learn to:

- Begin to understand own identity and the different groups they belong to.
- Understand how the roles and characteristics of boys and girls can be stereotyped.
- Find out about our community and the groups of people within it.

## Art

Children should learn to:

- Mix colours to make the correct shade.
- Create works of art using collage techniques.



## PE

Children should learn to:

- Develop a broader range of techniques and skills for attacking and defending
- Continue to develop ball skills learnt last term
- Know and apply the basic strategic and tactical principles of defence, and to adapt them to different situations
- Evaluate their own and others' work
- Know and understand the basic principles of warming up, and understand why it is important for a good quality performance
