Specific Areas

Literacy development: We will be reading stories and rhymes about People Who Help Us; talking, writing and using information books and the internet to find out more information about the police, fire service and the medical profession. We will be using our phonic skills to write labels, captions, sentences and stories as well as learning more tricky words and correct punctuation. We will continue to read, recite and write poems and rhymes. Also, we will continue to develop our letter formation skills.

Maths development: We will continue to develop understanding of numbers to 10 and above with addition and subtraction problems. We will be learning about 2d and 3d shapes and positional language, as well as measuring the height, weight and capacity of objects using comparative language such as longer, taller, shorter, greater, heavier and lighter. We will be learning to use everyday language when talking about time and we will continue to learn about using money through shop role play scenarios.

Understanding the world: We are hoping to have visitors into our Reception Classes to tell us about their job. We will continue to tend our 'garden areas' hopefully, harvesting, cooking and eating any vegetables. We will continue to look at technology in the world around us developing our skills with the ipads.
