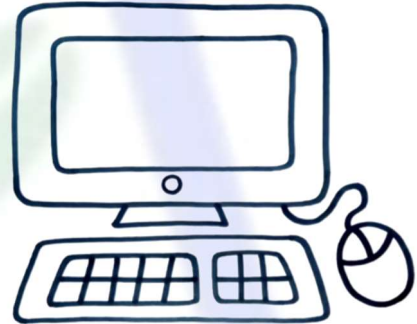


# Computing

Our children are growing up in an increasingly technological world and it is essential that they become familiar and confident with a range of devices including computers and iPads.

The school is well resourced to deliver the Computing curriculum with a computer suite, allowing whole classes to access individual networked workstations as well as several iPad trolleys that can be used in class, outdoors such as in the forest and on school trips to support children's learning. This range of technology supports a cross-curricular approach, embedding the core skills of Computing across all areas of the curriculum to ensure that pupils develop skills for the future.



Interactive whiteboards are used in all classes to support teaching and allow children to actively participate in learning experiences. Each class also has a class iPad. Platforms such as Class Dojo and Seesaw are used to showcase learning, recognise achievements and to also communicate with parents.

All classes are linked to the internet with a broadband connection and parents will be reassured that children cannot access any unsuitable material through secure in-school filter settings. Online safety is taught regularly which includes wellbeing online. Children are taught how to be safe online as well as being responsible digital citizens.
