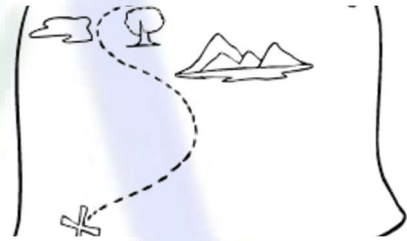


# Geography

Geography develops children's curiosity and fascination about the world and its people. Our geography teaching will endeavour to equip our pupils with knowledge about diverse places, people, resources and natural and human environments, together with a deep understanding of the Earth's key physical and human processes.

Children investigate the local area, including Epping Forest, and find out about countries that are far away. We use children's own experiences of visiting places to enrich their understanding of geography. In KS2 Geography pupils study the local area, the United Kingdom, Europe and North and South America.



The geography topics we study enable children to develop their:

- Location knowledge
- Place knowledge
- Human and physical geography
- Geographic skills and fieldwork

They learn how people can affect and change the environment and are encouraged to develop a sense of responsibility towards its care. To this end, our school has a team of Eco-Warriors who meet regularly and work alongside teachers to foster ways of making our school more eco-friendly. Recycling has been a major focus recently and children are becoming more aware of the need to conserve resources and participate in the Great British Clean Up.
