We provide opportunities for children to work with a variety of materials, such as wood, clay, textiles, food and natural items from the forest. They learn skills which will help them to design and make aesthetic, practical and useful objects, such as puppets, masks or wheeled vehicles.

They are given practical tasks to enable them to develop particular skills. They also investigate and evaluate simple products.

Food technology provides opportunities to learn about nutrition, hygiene, foods from other cultures and healthy eating. In addition to our own cookery room that is suitable for small groups of children, we have also created very good links with our local secondary school providing technology sessions for KS2 pupils.
